In Adam Fairclough's "Race and Democracy," the University of Georgia Press, 1995, I have attributed to me the following quote (page 330):

In Gardner's view, Shreveport contained
"more hate per square acre than any city in
the United States."

I did not make this statement. Fairclough footnotes this quote as "Gardner, Humphrey's interview, pp. 30-33" on page 535 of his notes.

The actual statement in the Humphrey interview (p. 30) is:

"I (i.e. Gardner) recall reading in a national magazine an account by a reporter who was following the Goldwater campaign when it came through this area in 1964, and he made the comment that Shreveport had been described as having more hate per acre than any city in the United States at that time."

As you can see, there is a difference in the actual quotation and that attributed to me. I desire to bring this to your attention.
