759 Ogilvie Hardware Company, Inc.



Description

Ogilvie Hardware was one of the largest jobbers of hardware in the Ark-La-Tex area and had been operating since 1907, when it first came into existence under the corporate name of Thomas-Davidson-Ogilvie Hardware Co. Inc. Ltd. The original incorporators were R.J. Ogilvie, E.A. Thomas and Fred Davidson. They began business at the corner of Travis and Strand streets.

Upon the death of Mr. Davidson in 1912 the name of the company was changed to Thomas-Ogilvie Hardware. In 1915 Mr. Thomas withdrew from the firm and Mr. Ogilvie succeeded him as president of the company, which position he held continuously until 1979. His brother W.B. Ogilvie Jr. took over the business and ran it until 1988. At that point, Burt Ogilvie became president and continued to serve in that capacity.

Ogilvie's distributed tools to lumber yards, feed and seed stores and hardware stores throughout the Ark-La-Tex. At one point the company peaked at 1,200 accounts with more than 40 employees. After 92 years in business this family business closed due to the competition of big box hardware stores such as Lowes, and Home Depot. Local business associates said that services provided by family-owned operations such as Ogilvie's are very hard to find.
