To: 'Brother' David Davis, Covington, St. Tamery [sic]
Re: gives birthdates of brothers and sisters;
two undated notes with death dates

- 2 From: Moses Davis, Nescopeck, Pa. October 24, 1824
To: 'son' David Davis, Covington, St. Tammery [sic]
Re: Stephen Bank died;
Joshua Kinny mortally wounded in wagon accident

- 3 From: Moses Davis, Berwick, Pa. January 18, 1827
To: 'son' David Davis, Covington
Re: William Engle farms with his father; barn, grain, hay burned up by lightning strike. River is frozen. Forty sleds on bridge. Making a canal from Lake Erie to the Ohio River to Delaware through Jersey to New York. Assembly making a law to connect the Susquehanna River to NY Stateline.

- 4 From: _____, Wooster Wayne County, Ohio July 12, 1831
To: David Davis, Covington
Re: The writer is having difficulties; he is foreman in a Hatter shop making \$1 a day. May be going to Cincinnati.

- 5 From: Moses Davis. Berwick, Pa. January 15, 1838
To: David Davis, Covington
Re: death of Hannah from dropsy; John was sick, now fine and working as tailor. William Engle, well and prosperous; new bridge over the river; sorrow at death of your young daughter.

- 6 Appointment: David Davis is appointed Fourth Captain Of Patrol for the 16th District of the 6th Ward. July 5, 1838

- 7 From: John Davis, Shreveport, Caddo Parish January 4, 1839
To: 'Brother' David Davis, Covington
Re: "we now have a post office"
